- The Millennium[®] multi-filter features the BioGrid[™] plate which provides high surface area for support of nitrifying bacteria that is totally separate from the mechanical and chemical filtration. This preserves the biological filter even when the MechaniChem[®] mechanical/chemical filtration cartridge is replaced.
- The new ImpellAir[®] pump assembly, using venturi action, mixes fresh air with aquarium water before it passes through the BioGrid[™] plate. As it passes through the plate, the biologically active surfaces are exposed to both dissolved oxygen in the water and undissolved oxygen in the air. This wet/dry action provides the nitrifying bacteria with much more oxygen than would normally be available, which greatly increases efficiency and capacity of biological filter.
- The MechaniChem® filtration cartridge contains two layers of polyester fabric enclosing activated carbon in a single convenient unit. The polyester fabric traps particles, while the activated carbon is housed in a unique baffle system that ensures the entire stream of water flows through carbon during every pass through the filter.
- The AdjustaFlow[®] telescopic siphon intake tube easily adjusts to various depths, and water flow is regulated by a top-mounted control. The flexible design permits easy removal of the intake tube for cleaning without removing the ImpellAir[®] assembly. The two units can be removed together in one single step for more significant cleaning.

The **BioGrid™** plate provides a high surface area for the biological filtration — oxidation of toxic ammonia to relatively non-toxic nitrate. Biological filtration remains intact even when mechanical/chemical filter is replaced.

Multi-filter maintenance is easy. Removal or replacement of the **BioGrid™** plate and the **MechaniChem®** filter can be done from the front of the tank. You don't even have to turn the **Millennium®** filter off.
